#### RG 380: Potter Interstate 66 Materials, 1958-1998

RG 380 contains material created and collected by Laurence Potter, measures .21 linear feet, and covers the years 1958-1998. Potter, worried that his home was in the path of the future Interstate 66 (I-66), started sending letters to staff within Arlington County and to the Virginia Department of Highways (VDH), expressing concern for his home and dissatisfaction with the way the VDH was handling the development of the project.
